

MyPass - Instructions to Create your Online Account

myPass.alberta.ca is a self-service website for Alberta students provided through Alberta Education. All high school students are required to sign up for this account. From this website, you will be able to:

- Order high school transcripts
- View diploma exam results
- Register to write or rewrite diploma exams (through online payment)
- View progress towards a high school diploma
- View and print Detailed Academic Report (DAR)
- View or update your personal information

To sign up, you will require your **Alberta Student Number (ASN)**, which can be found on your St. Joseph High School student ID card. You will also require a personal email address (**not school email**), and your current mailing address. **Prior to proceeding with the following steps, you will need to share your PERSONAL email address with a counsellor. This overrides the need for an access code to be sent to you in the mail.**

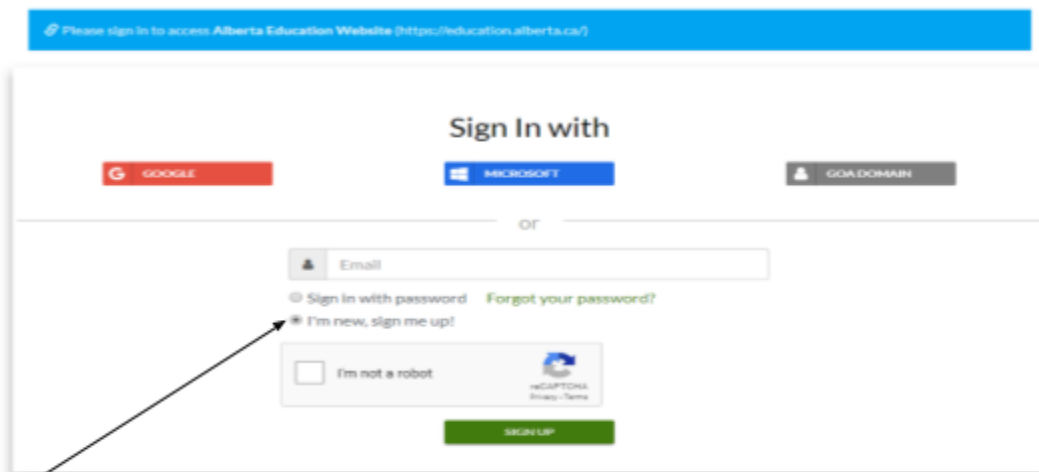
Instructions:

1. Type myPass.alberta.ca into your browser.
2. Click on “Sign in with Education Account”



3. Fill in your email. **DO NOT USE YOUR SCHOOL EMAIL.** When you graduate, your school email becomes disabled, which will make you unable to access myPass if you created an account with a school email address. Use a personal email like Gmail.
